B. COUNCIL REGULAR AGENDA

B-1. Consideration and possible approval of a Resolution approving and authorizing the execution of a Disaster Recovery Services Contract with AshBritt, Inc.

An emergency or urgent public necessity exists that requires immediate action of the City Council or an imminent threat to public health and safety or a reasonably unforeseeable situation exists, due to anticipated damages and flooding from Hurricane Laura, the Declarations of Disaster and mandatory evacuations in effect for the City, and the City's need for help and assistance from state and local government.

Chris Leavins, City Attorney, explained this was sent over by Aleta (Cappen, Emergency Management Coordinator). Mr. Leavins stated it is an extension of the contract from (Tropical Storm) Imelda for disaster debris pickup for one more year and will expire on August 26, 2021.

A motion was made by Councilmember Buesing, seconded by Councilmember Songe, to approve the Resolution authorizing the execution of the disaster recovery services contract with AshBritt. ROLL CALL VOTE: Councilmember Hannon, aye; Councilmember Jordan, aye; Councilmember Songe, aye; and Councilmember Buesing, aye. The Council voted four (4) for and none (0) opposed.
