NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Vidor City Council will meet in a Regular Meeting, on Thursday, the 9th day of March 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at Vidor City Hall, 1395 North Main Street, Vidor, Texas, for the following purposes:

A speaker may be directed to the appropriate department head for an answer to his or her question, or his or her concern may be placed on a future agenda for Council's consideration.

A member of the audience that desires to speak during City Council's consideration of any specific agenda item is requested to notify City staff prior to the start of the meeting.

Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.


