NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Vidor City Council will meet in a Special Meeting, on Thursday, the 7TH day of November 2024, at 7:00 p.m. at Vidor City Hall, 1395 North Main Street, Vidor, Texas, for the following purposes:

A. OPENING, PRESENTATIONS AND CITIZEN COMMENTS

A -1. Call to order and establishment of a Quorum.

A -2. Invocation and Pledge to the United States Flag and the State of Texas Flag

A -3. Citizen Comments

At this time, members of the audience may comment on any city-related subject not on the agenda. Anyone wishing to speak shall complete the appropriate form and deliver it to City staff prior to the meeting. Comments are limited to four minutes. The Texas Open Meetings Act prohibits the Council from discussing items not listed on the agenda. A speaker may be directed to the appropriate department head for an answer to his or her question, or his or her concern may be placed on a future agenda for the Council's consideration.

A member of the audience that desires to speak during the City Council's consideration of any specific agenda item is requested to notify City staff prior to the start of the meeting.

All speakers will have an opportunity to address the Council. All speakers will be asked to keep comments to less than four (4) minutes. A majority vote of City Council can force the Chair to end the speaker's comments or allow additional time.

Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in an open meeting.




