**A. OPENING, PRESENTATIONS, AND CITIZENS COMMENTS**

**A -1. Call to order and the establishment of a Quorum**

A quorum was present, and the Special Called Meeting of the Vidor City Council began at 6:48 p.m., Mayor Stiebig presiding.

**B. COUNCIL REGULAR AGENDA**

**B -1. Discussion and possible action on the extension and continuation of the Disaster Declaration dated March 20, 2020, and all amendments and supplements thereto, due to extension of Governor's Disaster Proclamation dated May 12, 2020**

**An emergency or urgent public necessity exists that requires immediate action of the City Council or an imminent threat to public health and safety or a reasonably unforeseeable situation exists, because of the expiration of the City's disaster declaration on May 14, 2020, at 11:59 p.m., the extension of the Governor's Disaster Proclamation on May 12, 2020 for an additional 30 days, and the City's need for help and assistance from state, federal and local government through a Disaster Declaration.**

Mayor Stiebig explained the Governor has extended his Declaration for another thirty (30) days. Chris Leavins, City Attorney, stated Governor Abbott waited until the 12<sup>th</sup> to make his extension and explained every time the Governor extends his Disaster Proclamation, it is for thirty days automatically. Mr. Leavins stated our meeting will be June 11<sup>th</sup> and recommended extending ours until that date, and then if Governor Abbott extends his, we can follow suit.


Councilmember Carder moved to extend our emergency order to mirror the Governor's. Councilmember Songe seconded. ROLL CALL VOTE: Councilmember Carder, aye; Councilmember

Jordan, aye; Councilmember Songe, aye; Councilmember Buesing, nay; and Councilmember Hill, aye. The Council voted four (4) for and one (1) opposed. The motion carried.

**B -2. Consideration of Adjournment**

A motion was made by Councilmember Songe, seconded by Councilmember Carder, for **Consideration of Adjournment**. The Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried, and the Emergency Special Called Meeting of the Vidor City Council adjourned at 6:51 p.m.
