C-3. Consideration and possible approval of a Resolution authorizing the execution of an Orange County Election Services Contract between the City of Vidor and Orange County Elections Administrator for the May 2023 Election.

Betty Strong, City Secretary informed council this will allow us to contract with the county for our May 2023 election.

A motion was made by Councilmember McGowan, seconded by Councilmember Thompson, to Approve the **Resolution authorizing the contract with Orange County Election Services.** The Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried

C -4. Consideration and possible action to approve a Committee Member to the Vidor Visitor Center Advisory Committee.

Robbie Hood, City Manager stated in a previous meeting the council approved four (4) of the five (5) members to the committee: Atasha Quebedeaux, John Nickum, Julie Hannon, and Jerry Aldridge. Mr. Hood asked the council to approve the fifth and final member to be Johnnie Andrus.

A motion was made by Councilmember McGowan, seconded by Councilmember Barker, to approve Johnnie Andrus as the fifth member of the Vidor Visitor Center Advisory Committee. The Council voted four (4) for and one (1) opposed with Gary Herrera councilmember Ward 5 being the opposed member. The motion carried.

C -5. Discussion and possible action to approve a RESOLUTION amending Resolution No. 1119 of the City Council authorizing the City's application and participation in the ALERRT Training grant program, a grant through the state of Texas.

Captain Rodney Johnson explained this resolution is to update the language to the previously approved resolution. Captain Johnson stated there are 2 new grant managers at the governor's office and this will satisfy the requirement to move this grant forward.

A motion was made by Councilmember McGowan, seconded by Councilmember Thompson, to approve the **Resolution amending Resolution 1119.** The Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried.
