

RESOLUTION NO. 908

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VIDOR, TEXAS
EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL
PROCLAMATION ON MARCH 20, 2020**

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of March, 2020, the City of Vidor, Texas (the "City") issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City, in response to the pandemic related to a novel coronavirus, now designated SARS-CoV2 which causes the disease COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the since the 20th day of March, 2020, and continuing through the date of this Resolution, the City has taken extraordinary measures to prevent the spread of this potentially devastating disease in our community;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures must continue to be taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in our community; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City that:

1. **Adoption of Recitals**. The City finds that the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein for all purposes and are found to be true and correct.
2. The declaration of disaster, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on the 20th day of March, 2020, shall be renewed and continued until 11:59 p.m. on the 13th day of April, 2020, in accordance with Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.
3. **Ratification**. All actions of the Mayor and the City Council regarding or relating to the Declaration of Disaster and the extension thereof are hereby ratified and approved.
4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
5. **Effective Date**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
