DRESS CODE

All persons entering the Courtroom must be **clean, neat, and dressed appropriately** so as to maintain the dignity, decorum and professional atmosphere of the Court and the administration of Justice.

The following information should serve as a *guide* on the clothing that is considered inappropriate or unacceptable for Court:

Shorts, capris, pants that are tattered or have holes in them, tank tops, halter tops, mid-drift exposing tops, muscle shirts, sleeveless shirts, cutoff shirts, caps, hats, do-rags, sunglasses, clothing that displays offensive, vulgar, racist, gang related, obscene language and/or graphics, dresses/skirts that are more than two (2) inches above the knee, clothing that exposes undergarments.

Any person not dressed in appropriate Courtroom attire is subject to removal.

YOU MUST HAVE ON SHOES TO ENTER THE COURT ROOM.

SHOES MUST COVER THE FOOT COMPLETELY.

DUE TO WARM WEATHER, THE JUDGE WILL ALLOW DRESSY SANDALS OR OPEN TOED HEELS.

THE COURT AND ONLY THE COURT WILL DECIDE WHAT IS APPROPRIATE AND WHAT IS NOT.

FLIP FLOPS OF ANY KIND OR SANDALS THAT LOOK LIKE FLIP FLOPS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
