

All persons entering the Courtroom must be clean, neat, and dressed appropriately so as to maintain the dignity, decorum and professional atmosphere of the Court and the administration of Justice.

The following information should serve as a *guide* on the clothing that is considered <u>inappropriate</u> or <u>unacceptable</u> for Court:

Shorts, capris, pants that are <u>tattered</u> or <u>have holes</u> in them, tank tops, halter tops, mid-drift exposing tops, muscle shirts, sleeveless shirts, cutoff shirts, caps, hats, do-rags, sunglasses, clothing that displays offensive, vulgar, racist, gang related, obscene language and/or graphics, dresses/skirts that are more than two (2) inches above the knee, clothing that exposes undergarments.

> Any person not dressed in appropriate Courtroom attire is subject to removal.

YOU MUST HAVE ON SHOES TO ENTER THE COURT ROOM.

SHOES MUST COVER THE FOOT <u>COMPLETELY.</u>

SHOES WITH OPEN TOES AND/OR OPEN HEELS ARE NOT ALLOWED. WATER SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED. FLIP FLOPS AND SANDALS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

DURING WARM WEATHER THE JUDGE WILL ALLOW DRESSY OPEN TOED/OPEN HEELED SHOES WITH A HIGH HEEL.

THE COURT AND ONLY THE COURT WILL DECIDE WHAT IS APPROPRIATE AND WHAT IS NOT.
